



2017 Hsin-Yi Children's Animation Awards

Why We're Holding this Event

We aim to improve both the quality of video entertainment targeted at children and their ability to appreciate it. At the same time, we want to award talented people who contribute to animations and videos around the world for providing a more diverse selection of good material for children.

The Prizes

International Division

Top prize (1) : US\$2,000 (approx. NT\$60,000) and award

Taiwan Division

Top prize (1) : NT\$100,000 and award

Runner-up (1) : NT\$50,000 and award

What Can be Submitted

- Works must be age-appropriate animated videos for children aged 3 - 10
- The competition is open to any work published after July 15, 2015
- There are no nationality restrictions for International Division submissions
- Submissions to the Taiwan Division must be created by a local Taiwanese production team
- Submissions are open from April 1 to July 31, 2017.

Criteria for Judging

- Preliminaries : Submissions are entered into the competition after being selected by a panel of preliminary judges.
- Finals : A second panel of judges selects top prize and runner-up winners. The judges may elect not to choose a recipient if no submissions match their criteria.
- Results will be publicized at an awards ceremony in October 2017. Winners' names and the specific date will be published, on the Hsin-Yi Foundation website, and on kimy.com.tw.

Formats and Additional Information

- **Length** : Videos must be 15 minutes or less in length
- **Format** : DVD (1920x1080 NTSC) with MPG, MPG4, MOV or AVI file format. Please write your full name, the title of the submission, and the length of the video on the disc and ensure it can be played back properly before submitting.
- **Required** : Signed application form and CD/DVD featuring the following information
 1. Digital copy of application form
 2. 3-5 still captures from video in JPEG format (300 dpi or above preferred)
 3. 1 photo of director in JPEG format (300 dpi or above preferred)
 4. English subtitles for any dialogue or narration that is not in either English or Chinese
 5. Anything else you would like to include (such as list of professional achievements, promotional posters, etc.)

Terms And Conditions

- Participants who submit their works for the International or Taiwan Divisions must agree to provide their submissions to the event organizer free of charge for public screening as necessitated by the awards presentation and promotional activities. The event organizer reserves the right to use a 30-second clip from the submission for the sake of promoting this event.
- Entrants are obliged to declare the rights for the awards to use the copy text, stills, posters, videos, of the films and information on the personnel once being selected for the purposes of promotion, related events, and documentation for the awards, and Hsin-Yi Foundation (the organizer)
- Hsin-Yi Foundation will own the exclusive publication rights for the top prize-winning work in the Taiwan Division. Hsin-Yi Foundation will possess priority rights of publication for the runner-up prize in that division. (These rules do not apply to International Division winners.)
- Each entrant declares to be the author or rights owner of the film(s) in competition and to own all the literary, dramatic and musical rights. If the film(s) has involved in the case of breaching copyright at any level, the organizer will reserve the right to revoke the award.
- Matters not mentioned in these regulations will be decided by the Hsin-Yi Foundation (the organizer).
